A. CALL TO ORDER

The October 11, 2023, Regular Board Meeting of the County Line Drainage District (the "District") was called to order at 10:00 a.m. at 23351 North River Road, Alva, Florida 33920.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES1. June 28, 2023, Public Hearing & Regular Board Meeting

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A motion was made by Mr. Fabry seconded by Mr. McKenna and passed unanimously approving June 28, 2023, Public Hearing & Regular Board Meeting minutes, as presented.

2. July 11, 2023, Special Board Meeting and Attorney-Client Session

The minutes of the July 11, 2023, Special Board Meeting and Attorney-Client Session were presented for consideration.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Fabry, seconded by Mr. McKenna and passed unanimously approving the minutes of the July 11, 2023, Special Board Meeting and Attorney-Client Session, as presented.

G. OLD BUSINESS

There were no Old Business items to come before the Board.

H. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Resolution No. 2023-04 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Amended Budget

Resolution No. 2023-04 was presented, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY LINE DRAINAGE DISTRICT AUTHORIZING AND ADOPTING AN AMENDED FINAL FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023 BUDGET, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 197, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Fabry, seconded by Mr. McKenna and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2023-04, as presented.

I. MANAGER'S REPORT 1. Financial Report

Ms. Meneely went over financial report. There were no questions from the Members of the Board.

Ms. Meneely reminded the Board that their next meeting was scheduled for January 10, 2024.

J. FIELD REPORT

Mr. Sebring went over his report in the agenda packet. He stated that the culvert in Section 3 had been reordered and he is waiting for it to come in. Mr. Beale stated that the road blew out and washed out the culvert so emergency repairs were needed at a cost of \$13,500.

A motion was made by Mr. McKenna, seconded by Mr. Fabry and passed unanimously ratifying the \$13,500 expense.

Mr. Sebring then advised that he would be resigning from the CLDD and Brandon Lynn was recommended to take over the Field Inspector position beginning January 1. Mr. Beale stated they would come up with a charge

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for Fl Agriculture Management for Brandon's time. There was a consensus of the Board to get a proposal from Florida. Agriculture Management for Brandon Lynn to serve as the new Field Inspector.

K. ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Grandusky went over the rainfall amounts for the past month, stating that water from Babcock Ranch began flowing into the District which caused the fall out of the culvert between Sections 2 & 3. He estimated the repair cost at \$15,000-\$20,000, further stating that the repair should be completed during the dry season.

Mr. Fabry asked for an update on the County Line ditch and Mr. Grandusky stated that the grant had been delayed and the project would have to be re-bid.

L. ATTORNEY'S REPORT

Mr. Bayne advised that the litigation was ongoing and there is an anticipated mediation set for December.

Mr. Bayne added that he would attend the Florida Association of Special District's Legislative quarterly meeting.

M. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

There were no Administraive Matters to come before the Board.

N. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mr. Fabry asked when the water permit expired and Mr. Grandusky indicated he would need to investigate it and would bring the information back to the Board.

Mr. McKenna stated that the dike on the north end needed to be mowed and he was working on getting a long arm mower to do the work. Mr. Fabry indicated that now would be the time to do it. There was a consensus of the Board to move forward with the project.

O. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, a **motion** was made by Mr. Fabry, seconded by Mr. McKenna and passed unanimously adjourning the Regular Board Meeting at 10:30 a.m.
